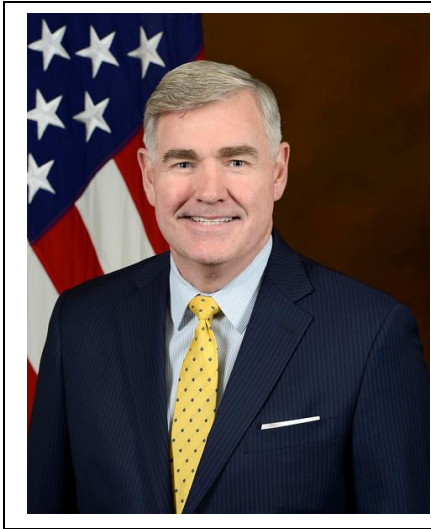

Stuart K. Archer is the Director of Executive Travel. He manages a Directorate of 151 civilians, Soldiers, and contractors that provide transportation services and policies for the Army and Department of Defense senior leaders. As Director, he oversees the management of the Transport Services Division which provides ground transportation to senior leaders of the Department of Defense. His duties also includes providing management supervision over the Passport Services Division which serves as the DoD Executive Agent for DoD official passports amounting to over 190,000 actions annually. Additionally, he provides supervision for the development and execution of travel policy guidance for the Secretary of the Army.
